Pray for your church, its ministries, and its impact on your community.
Pray for your pastor, your staff, your deacons, and other church leadership.

Pray for revival and spiritual awakening

Revival is when Christians return whole-heartedly to the Lord and seek Him passionately.
Spiritual awakening is when a significant ingathering of unbelievers turn to the Lord.

Pray for the lost

Pray specifically, by name, for those in your life who need to know Jesus.
Make a list and commit to pray until they come to faith.
Pray about how the Lord can use you in the process of bringing those folks to Him.

Pray for missions and missionaries

Pray specifically, not just “God bless the missionaries”.
Get prayer requests from www.imb.org & www.namb.net.

Pray for the nations and people groups of the world.

Go to www.operationworld.org for prayer prompts for the nations.
(There are 6,599 unreached people groups in the world.)
Go to www.peoplegroups.org to pray for unreached and unengaged people groups.

Pray for persecuted Christians around the world.

Draw upon the headlines for specifics to pray.

Pray for your city

Pray for God’s blessing and spiritual renewal.
Pray for your city leaders.
Pray for your schools, for administrators, teachers, and the children.
Pray for the churches of your city and unity among Christian as a witness to the lost. (John 17:20-23)

Pray for the government

National, state, county, and local leaders (1 Timothy 2:1-4)

Pray about social issues that impact our society and culture

The undermining of the family (divorce, homosexuality, pornography, etc.)
Abortion and other life issues (euthanasia, cloning, stem-cell research, etc.)
The negative values propagated by the entertainment industry
Race, prejudice, and discrimination; the lgbt agenda;
human trafficking; religious liberty; gambling; and other issues

Pray that God’s Kingdom would be realized in your own life

Pray that your life would exemplify Matthew 5:3-16;
Galatians 5:22-25; 2 Peter 1:3-11; Philippians 4:6-9;
Romans 12:1-3; 12:9-21; Isaiah 6:8

Prayerwalk your church, inside and out.
Walk the hallways and as you come to each room, think about the classes and activities that take place in that space.
Pray for the teachers, leaders, and those they lead.
Pray for hearts and lives to be touched and changed.

Pray the news. As you sit down to read the newspaper or online news sites, pray about the things you read.
Pray for those impacted by tragedy. Pray for leaders involved in making decisions that affect our lives. Pray for God to work and in and through world events that He might be glorified.

Pray Scripture. Find passages that speak to Kingdom issues.
